

Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper - Tuesday, Feb. 13th 5 pm to 7 pm





Lenten Series - Begins Wednesday February 21st at 6:45 p.m.- Dr.



Join us starting **Wednesday evening February 21st at 6:45 pm** for the beginning of our Lent Study. This season we will join the Diocese and read **Dr. Samuel Wells' book** *Humbler Faith Bigger God: Finding a story to Live By.*"

We encourage you to read the whole book in the coming weeks and we will be discussing certain chapters at each gathering.

About the book:

Humbler Faith, Bigger God is a book of apologetics. Each of the ten chapters considers a timely (timeless?) criticism of Christianity or the Church. Wells tells the "old, old story: a broadly traditional, orthodox Christianity" before challenging it with the criticism of the "rival story – what an educated, rational, contemporary person would generally think."

Wells concludes each chapter with "a story to live by," a response to both the "old, old," and the "rival," that serves "as a constructive vision for a renewed Christian faith."

This will be a *fun time* to gather, play games and go on small trips together. There will be pizza, movies, mini golf, board and video games!


We will get together every other week or about twice a month and will work around holidays, breaks and other events as needed for students and families. Bring a friend and we hope to see you all there!

THE Harvest

Hot Times in the Heartland Documentary Preview Rescheduled for Feb. 25 at 2

pm



Bishop Cathleen Bascom is among those featured in a new, feature-length documentary entitled "Hot Times in the Heartland."

The documentary spotlights individuals and organizations directly involved with research and implementation of approaches designed to mitigate the impact of climate change and to help communities develop more resilience as we adapt to changing conditions. The documentary explores a range of activities taking place primarily within the Kaw Valley of Kansas and the metropolitan Kansas City area.

Bishop Bascom describes the current situation as a "Kairos moment" for Earth stewardship, and shares how the Episcopal Diocese of Kansas is

responding through the Creation Trustees Network and the ministries of Bethany House & Garden.

Members of the diocese are invited to attend a screening of the documentary on Sunday, February 25 at 2 pm at Grace Cathedral, Topeka in All Saints Hall. The film will be shown in its entirety, and there will be a discussion facilitated by the bishop and producer Dave Kendall, former host of the "Sunflower Journeys" series on public television.
